Arrival at Sywell Aerodrome

Sywell Aerodrome is a large and busy licenced airfield with a hotel, restaurant, flying schools, commercial flying and a lot of industry on the same site.

Please remember that the aerodrome is active at all times and you must respect the other users on the aerodrome.

EMC2010 competitors are provided with dedicated camping and parking areas on the aerodrome.

Use NN60BN in your navigation system. Look for the EMC2010 signs on the roads approaching Sywell. Find the one with 'COMPETITORS' and turn into the campsite area:

This leads to a car park and campsite area. You may drive your cars onto the campsite when you set up your tents, but please park all cars on the car park during the championships.



The campsite is on the north east side of the aerodrome. Use NN60BN in Google maps. The campsite area is in red:

Campsite guidelines

Caravans and motorhomes may be parked in your team areas.

Please leave roadways in the campsite clear so that other teams can drive into their team area.

Some caravan and motorhome electricity 'hook-ups' are available for €25 or £20 for 13 days. Please ask Event Director Rob Hughes. You must bring your own 'hook-up' electricity cable for your caravan. Please bring the longest one you have!

Showers and toilets are available. Please leave them clean after you use them.

Water is available on the campsite.

The campsite is separated from the airfield by a fence.

Aircraft parking is next to the campsite, behind the Czech, German and British team areas (and on the other side of the fence).

Electricity

We use British plugs and sockets at 230V:



Please bring extension leads and adaptors to make sure you can use the electricity in the way that you want.

Money

The local businesses will only accept £ sterling. Most will not accept euros. There are many banks nearby.

Remember to bring 3 national flags, approximately 150 x 225 cm (see bulletin 1).

Bring a CD of the your national anthem – in standard format (see bulletin 1).
