RESTRICTION OF FLYING REGULATIONS - JET FORMATION DISPLAY SITES AUGUST - SEPTEMBER 2003

The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Jet Formation Display Sites (No 3)) Regulations 2003

1 Temporary Restricted Airspace is established for selected sites in the United Kingdom, the Isle of Man and the Channel Islands to protect jet formation aerobatic teams such as the Red Arrows, Frecce Tricolori and Patrouille de France. Formation aerobatics require great concentration and skill both from the leader and other members of the formation. The pilots cannot be expected to make unscheduled violent changes in speed, altitude or direction in order to avoid other conflicting aircraft. Any distraction caused by aircraft conflicting with the flight path of the formation could result in a collision between display aircraft or between display aircraft and other aircraft which had entered the display area. In order to protect display aircraft, other air traffic and spectators, a Statutory Instrument (SI) or Statutory Document (SD) has been made prohibiting access by civil aircraft to the airspace within which a formation jet display team will perform. The SI/SD contains respective details of the locations and areas of the displays which are listed in the Annexe to this Circular.

2 The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by Article 85 of the Air Navigation Order 2000, hereby makes the following Regulations:

- (a) Subject to paragraph (b), no aircraft shall fly within the area bounded by a circle of 6 nm radius, centred on the position specified in Column 2 of the Schedule hereto, below the altitude (amsl) and on the days indicated respectively in that Schedule during such periods of time as may be notified for the purpose of this Regulation;
- (b) paragraph (a) shall not apply to any aircraft flying within Controlled Airspace or an Aerodrome Traffic Zone, in respect of which there is an appropriate Air Traffic Control Unit, in accordance with the permission of that Unit;
- (c) where such airspace falls within the territorial boundaries of the Isle of Man or the Channel Islands Airspace supporting legislation has been introduced.

2.1 Times for each display will be notified separately by NOTAM, feature in the daily AIS Information Line message (0500-354802) and be included on the Pre-flight Information Bulletins (PIB) through the AIS Web site at: http://www.ais.org.uk
